Background: Ph.D. students are required to take 9 basic required courses: (1) Soc 202A, (2) Soc 202B, (3) Soc 210A, (4) Soc 210B, (5) Soc 220A, (6) Soc 221A, (7) Soc 221B, (8) Soc 221C, and (9) an Advanced Sociological Methodology course. In addition, students are required to take 9 sociology seminars as electives. These 18 courses are required for advancement to Ph.D. candidacy.
